ach year, Children's Hospital of Richmond at VCU (CHoR) provides care for over 60,000 children. CHoR's primary service area is the Richmond Metro area and the Tri-Cities. Approximately 250,000 children live in those communities, and nearly 1 out of every 8 children in the region visited the hospital for care in 2017 alone.



Coin Collection Campaigns

This is one of the most popular fundraisers within our Change for Children Campaign! Give each class a canister and create a friendly competition between classrooms or grade levels to have a race to see who can fill their can the fastest. Or ask for donations at any event, including sporting events, school theater productions, open houses, and many others. Children's Hospital Foundation can provide small donation canisters (pictured below) if needed.



Other Fundraising Ideas

- Break the Dress Code Day Students and teachers make a
 donation to break the dress code for
 a day—it could be jeans, pajamas,
 school spirit attire... or anything you
 want!
- Walk/Run Host a walk/run during gym class, and have students get donations or pledges to see how many laps they can go.

 School Dance Find a teacher or administrator that loves music and ask that they bring in their iPod for a school dance, and charge \$1 for students to attend.
- Special Events Host an event like a movie night or car wash and ask people to give donations.
